

UNDERGROUND

- Development mining operations continued in the Bellbird South area.
- Longwall B4 commenced on 5 October 2017. Approximately 828m of retreat completed by 22 May 2018 of total panel length 1125m.
- Encountered recent difficulties with B4 longwall face so evaluating options.
- One development miner has completed work for Bellbird South with some associated staff redeployed to Ashton Coal Mine.
- Viability of Stage 3 is still under assessment.









- Subsidence surveys are ongoing along Sandy Creek Road monitoring line.
- Maximum recorded surface level movement is approx. 461 mm on Sandy Creek Road.






















Dust Deposition Gauge D1 - Insoluble Solids




Dust Deposition Gauge D2 - Insoluble Solids






Dust Deposition Gauge D3 - Insoluble Solids




Dust Deposition Gauge D4 - Insoluble Solids






Dust Deposition Gauge D5 - Insoluble Solids




Dust Deposition Gauge D7 - Insoluble Solids









Yancoal Austar Groundwater Monitoring (G1828C)




Figure 3 Stage 2 alluvium and sandstone aquifer, and NOW groundwater level hydrographs





Austar Peak Ground Vibration - Night and Day Combined (Events > 1mm/sec)






Noise control works

Environment Protection Licence Variation


- EPA applied a Pollution Study to the licence regarding containment and investigations at a CHPP drainage line where orange residue was identified and reported to EPA in June 2017.
- A geotechnical ground and groundwater investigation including five investigation boreholes and five test pits to investigate potential sources of water flowing into the CHPP Northern Drainage Line was carried out in March and the report submitted to the EPA 29 March 2018.
